



## Goat - chicken project

A total of \$1358.75 has been received for the purchase of goats and chickens for the self sufficiency project for the North District of Haiti. Of that amount, \$906.00 is designated for chickens and \$419.75 for goats. The Chicken Project is set to begin within the next few months. There has been much discussion on the Goat Project: both the congregations at St. Raphael and Dondon are very interested in raising goats. One possible scenario, (which is used in a southern district of Haiti) is that the church buys some nannies and a couple of good bucks, then gives bred nannies to some church families. The families must then give the first two kids to two other families, and as the program progresses, more and more families own goats. This plan is being considered in the North District. Donations for the cost of goats and/or chickens would be greatly appreciated. Goats cost \$75-\$80 each and chickens about \$5 each.

## Shipping Container - Lori S

The semi-trailer, due to be sent to Haiti as soon as there is enough money and goods, is filling up, however, there is still room for donations. If you have items you would like to donate please contact Lori Salvhus (218) 935-9016 or Lil Spilde (218) 333-1560 and arrangements will be made to collect them. Please check the list on our website: [lmamn.org](http://lmamn.org). Items should be packed in sturdy boxes (apple boxes are great!) and marked for contents. It would be helpful if school kits and such are in a zip lock bag before being put in a cardboard box.

Money is needed to help with the cost of shipping the container. Total costs including customs runs close to \$10,000. Many of the goods we send may not be available, or at prohibitive cost to the Haitians, plus the Haitian people will know first-hand the love and care shown by their Christian brothers and sisters in the USA.

The storage trailer is on the property of Dick Schmidt, 4.5 miles south of Bemidji's south intersection of Hwys 2 and 71, and 1 mile east on County Rd 9. We have enough women's clothes, except for small-size dresses and shoes (no high heels) so please do not

bring/send any more.

### Some of the things needed are:

Church: tables, musical instruments (non electric), French language Bibles, Luther's small catechism in French

Sewing Center: large spools of thread, fabric

Cooking Center: kitchenware, family kits\*, apt size refrigerator, propane cook stove

Clinic: Exam tables, cabinets, over-the-counter meds, metal crutches, walkers, storage tubs (contact Deb Larson at [debsdoodles@yahoo.com](mailto:debsdoodles@yahoo.com))

Schools: School kits\*, hygiene kits\*, chalkboards, chalk, erasers, kindergarten mats, backpacks, Bibles & catechisms (in French)

Clothing: Shoes (no high heels), rain boots, women's dresses (no plus sizes), socks & underwear, men's clothes (no plus sizes), scarves, gloves

Other things: Spades, hammers, shovels, hand saws, screwdrivers, cement screws, hand operated cement mixers, portable generators (gas or diesel), water pumps, chicken wire, 5-gal. containers of paint - esp off white and tan screening, tents and tarps, PVC pipes and joints, chain link fencing, bed frames & mattresses, copiers, printers, cases of copy paper

As you might know, there are a lot of expenses related to the operation of a school and church. Pastors need to be paid as do teachers. Some of their pay comes via the Adopt-A-Student program, but there is always a shortage before the end of the school year. Each of the five churches has a building program in place, and those buildings need to be finished. Rooms need to be divided for classrooms, toilets dug and maintained. Accessibility to water for cooking of noon lunches and hand-washing is necessary. Transportation for pastors is always needed. The amount coming in the collection plate is a VERY small amount, and is a small contribution to the expenses.
